OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION RE OPENING OF ATS KARACHI AND LAHORE, ON RELAXING COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

The APSAA Training Schools were closed on Governments instruction to safe guard against **COVID-19**. Now with relaxation in instructions, it has been decided to reopen both the **ATS** from **1st June 2020**.

Following SOPs will be followed:

1. TIMINGS:
Saturday to Thursday: **9:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m**
Friday will be closed holiday for maintenance.
2. Only persons in uniform with surgical gloves and masks will be allowed.
3. Companies will bring sanitizer for their own guards.
4. Temperature will be checked individually at entrance by APSAA staff. Guard having high grade fever will be returned along with other guards of same company.
5. In addition companies will send a certificate that all guards are clear of **COVID 19**.
6. Members are requested to book three days in advance max group of **Ten (10)** Guards, to ensure social distancing.
